




# **Venue Specific EAP Location: Soccer Practice Fields**

#### Venue Directions

- o Address: 9500 E. 16<sup>th</sup> Street, Indianapolis, IN 46229
- From 21<sup>st</sup> Street: Turn onto Lakeview Drive and head south. The soccer practice fields are on the west side (right side) of the road (open grassy area).
- From Mitthoeffer Road: Turn onto Heather Hills Drive and head west to Lakeside Drive.
  Turn right onto Lakeside Drive and head north. The soccer practice field is on the west side (left side) of the road (open grassy area).



### Emergency Personnel

- o Certified Athletic Trainers are on Campus for most home practices.
- Warren Township Police on site for after school activities
- Warren Central Soccer Coaching Staff Certified in CPR, AED, & First Aid

# Emergency Communication

Cellular phones will be used to contact athletic training staff for medical assistance.
 Athletic Trainers will also carry Warren Township Radios at Administration's discretion and can be reached through those as a secondary means of communication.

### Emergency Equipment

- ATC will have the following equipment in the Athletic Training Facility and will bring it with them in the gator to the practice fields.
  - ATC's Kit
    - Includes: rescue inhaler, Epi-pen, stethoscope, BP cuff, pulse oximeter, SAM splint, sling, penlight, biohazard bags, gloves, tape, and other emergency medical supplies
  - Cramer Vacuum Splints
  - AED
- If ATC is not on site at time of emergency Venue Specific AED is located at the Soccer Game Field across Lakeside Drive on the East Side of concession stand/bathroom building at the southwest corner of the Soccer Game Field.

## Roles of First Responders

- Contact Certified Athletic Trainer (if not present)
- o Immediate care of injured/ill athlete
- Equipment Retrieval
- Activation of EMS (call 911):
  - Identify yourself
  - Identify nature of emergency
  - Age, sex, and sport of athlete
  - Location
  - Care already provided
  - Give them a contact phone number
  - Identify who will meet EMS
  - Directions (see above)
  - Any other information they ask
  - DO NOT HANG UP UNTIL THEY DO!!!!!
- Notify Warren Township Police and/or other administration as necessary
  - Through Radio "Any 800"
  - Daytime Phone: 317-532-5643
  - After Hour Line: 317-258-1363
- Direct EMS to scene:
  - Open appropriate doors/gates
  - Designate individual to direct EMS to exact scene
  - Limit entry to just medical staff
  - Answer questions/assist EMS as needed
- Control Traffic and Observers to allow EMS to work
- Keep other players clear of the area
